Beginning for the description of the claim at corner 1 granite stone 9x13x12 inches above ground, elevated 1000 and 1000, with ground of stone, identical with corner 10 of the Golden Nugget Placer claim No. 5225, from which line, southwest corner of section eight, in town seven, south of range seventy seven west, South Principal meridian, two and nine degrees, thirty eight minutes and thirty seconds west two thousand and sixty two and forty four hundred the feet distant. Thence, thence, north forty one degrees and fifty seven minutes west five hundred and twenty feet Gold Run Outlet; one thousand one hundred and sixty and six tenths feet to corner No 2.
