East, to wit:
 Beginning at Corner No 1, a granite rock 27x13x9 inches. Chiseled 1-5225, with cross at corner point, with mound of stone, from which a pine tree twelve inches in diameter marked B. T. 1-5225 bears north fifty eight degrees and forty five minutes east thirty six and six tenths feet distant, and the northwest corner of section seventeen, in township seven, south of range seventy seven west, sixth principal meridian, bears north sixty nine degrees and forty six minutes east eight hundred and eighty three and thirty six hundredths feet distant.
 Thence, first course, magnetic variation thirteen degrees and twenty eight minutes east, south one degree and twenty four minutes west, One thousand, two hundred and forty five and seven tenths feet to Corner No 2
 Thence, second course, magnetic variation thirteen degrees and twenty eight minutes east, south forty five degrees and nine minutes west. Two hundred and ninety nine feet to Corner No 3.
 Thence, third course, magnetic variation thirteen degrees and twenty six minutes east, south thirty degrees and twenty four minutes west, One thousand one hundred and ninety eight and five tenths feet to Corner No 4.
 Thence, fourth course, magnetic variation thirteen degrees and twenty five minutes east, north fifty eight degrees and forty five minutes west One hundred and fifty feet intersect east bank of Blue River, One hundred and ninety three feet intersect west bank of Blue River, One thousand one hundred and sixty three feet to
