On the sixth day of July, A. D. 1860, duly enter and pay for that certain PLACER claim and premises, designated by the Surveyor General as T. G. 136.223, known as the Gold Nugget and Bear Nugget Nos. 2, placer mining claims, and embracing a section of sections seven, eight, sixteen, seventeen and eighteen, in Township nine south and forty-one west of the Principal Meridian in the Highwood & Barnes Mining District, in the County of Summit and State of Colorado, in the District under subject to sale at Layardville and bounded, described, and allotted as follows: magnetic variation four degrees east and thirty minutes east.

Beginning for the description of the first claim at corner of section eight, intersecting south of range forty-one south, forty-one west, Principal Meridian, bearing nine degrees, thirty-eight minutes and Thirty seconds east Two Thousand hundred and sixty-two and forty-four hundredths feet first dist. Then, one course, north forty-one degrees and fifty-seven minutes east five hundred and twenty feet Gold Town Ditch; one thousand one hundred and sixty and sixty feet to corner No. 2. Then, second course, south forty-three degrees and eighteen minutes west three hundred and forty-seven feet thirteen and one hundred and thirty-three and ninety feet to corner No. 3. Then, third course, south thirty-three degrees east four hundred and one feet one and nine-tenths feet to corner No. 4. Then, fourth course, south fifty-three degrees and ten minutes west ninety-nine and ninety-nine feet one hundred and thirteen feet to corner No. 5; Then, fifth course, south nineteen degrees and thirty-nine minutes west two thousand three hundred and eight and seventy-nine feet to corner No. 6. Then, sixth course, south eighty-nine degrees and eight minutes west one thousand two hundred and two feet to corner No. 7.
